

Greetings Fellow Medical Logisticians!

The AMEDDC&S is now offering, the Hospital Medical Logistics Course (6I-F9/6H-F40/341-F1), for FY09. The two iterations are 5-23 January and 3-21 August 2009.

There is limited central funding for active-duty CONUS based Soldiers.

Course scope:

The course provides focused training in the principles and techniques required to manage medical logistics functions in support of MEDDACs, MEDCENs and MTF's. The course provides instruction and advanced application of medical logistics management, automation systems, inventory management, property management, facilities management, environment of care, procurement and acquisition, Joint Commission, life-cycle maintenance, supply chain management, cold chain management, national and retail Class VIII requisitions, Installation Medical Supply Activity (IMSA) roles and responsibilities, storage and quality control procedures for Class VIII.

Audience:

This course is open to senior O-3 and above Medical Service Corps Commissioned Officers (AOC 70K and Combined Logistics Captain's Career Course or AMEDD Captain's Career Course graduate), Warrant Officers in the grade of CW2 and above (MOS 670A), Non-Commissioned Officers in the grade of E-7 and above (MOS 68A and 68J), and DA civilians in the grade of GS-11 and above (or pay band equivalent) currently serving or enroute to hospital logistics management positions
