1. GENERAL GUIDANCE:

A. THE LONG TERM HEALTH EDUCATION AND TRAINING (LTHET) SELECTION BOARD WILL CONVENE O/A 4 MAY 2009 TO SELECT ACTIVE DUTY MS OFFICERS TO ENTER TRAINING IN ANNUAL YEAR 2010. THIS PROGRAM DOES NOT APPLY TO AGR, USAR, OR ARNG OFFICERS.

B. INFORMATION AND RELATED APPLICATION DOCUMENTS REGARDING MS LTHET AND OTHER AMEDD LEADER DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS CAN ALWAYS BE ACCESSED AT THE FOLLOWING

C. ALL PROGRAMS OPEN FOR APPLICATION ARE LISTED IN DETAIL AT THE END OF THIS MESSAGE. THEY ARE LISTED BY THE TYPE OF PROGRAM (PhD, MASTERS DEGREE, DEGREE COMPLETION, FELLOWSHIPS, INTERNSHIPS, TRAINING WITH INDUSTRY, SEPARATE COURSES, AND RESIDENCIES).

D. ALL PROGRAMS MAY REQUIRE A SPECIFIC UTILIZATION TOUR. APPLYING OFFICERS SHOULD DISCUSS POSSIBLE UTILIZATION TOURS WITH THEIR CONSULTANT AND CAREER MANAGER.

E. FOR INFORMATION REGARDING THE TYPES OF EVALUATIONS (OER vs. AER) RECEIVED BY PARTICIPATING IN LTHET PROGRAMS, OFFICERS SHOULD CONSULT AR 623-3, CHAPTER 3 AND APPENDIX E.

F. ACTIVE DUTY SERVICE OBLIGATIONS (ADSOs) WILL VARY DEPENDING ON THE TYPE OF PROGRAM AND THE LENGTH (IN MONTHS OR YEARS) OF THE PROGRAM. OFFICERS SHOULD CONSULT AR 351-3 FOR QUESTIONS REGARDING ADSOs.

G. OFFICERS WHO ARE SELECTED FOR MS LTHET PROGRAMS ARE CURRENTLY EXEMPT FROM STOP LOSS / STOP MOVE. HOWEVER, IF AN MS OFFICER IS SELECTED FOR AN LTHET PROGRAM AND IS CURRENTLY DEPLOYED OR PENDING A DEPLOYMENT, IT MAY BE IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE OFFICER AND THE UNIT TO DEFER THE OFFICER'S ATTENDANCE UNTIL REDEPLOYMENT AND POST DEPLOYMENT STABILIZATION HAS OCCURRED. APPLYING OFFICERS MUST TAKE THIS GUIDANCE INTO CONSIDERATION AND THEY ARE ENCOURAGED TO DISCUSS THEIR OPTIONS WITH THEIR CAREER MANAGER, CONSULTANT, AND THE AMEDD LEADER DEVELOPMENT OFFICE.

3. ALL LTHET APPLICATIONS WILL REQUIRE:

A. DA FORM 3838 APPLICATION FOR PROFESSIONAL TRAINING (SEP 07). OFFICERS MAY NOT APPLY FOR MORE THAN TWO (2) PROGRAMS. BOTH PROGRAMS SHOULD BE ENTERED ON ONE FORM IN BLOCK 18 & 19 EXACTLY AS THEY ARE SPECIFIED IN THE SECTIONS AT THE END OF THIS MESSAGE.

B. COMMANDER'S HEIGHT/WEIGHT/BODY FAT STANDARDS/APFT MEMORANDUM CERTIFYING THE OFFICER IS IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE STANDARDS SET FORTH IN AR 600-9. THE REQUIRED FORMAT IS PROVIDED AT ENCLOSURE 1 OF THIS MESSAGE.

C. TRANSCRIPTS. OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS NOT IN IPERMS (THE OFFICER'S ELECTRONIC RECORD) MUST BE RECEIVED IN HARD COPY TO APPLY FOR ANY LTHET PROGRAM.

D. DA PHOTOGRAPH. APPLICANTS MUST ENSURE THEY HAVE A CURRENT DA PHOTO. A CURRENT PHOTO IS GENERALLY DEFINED AS ONE IN THE OFFICER'S CURRENT RANK AND DUTY ASSIGNMENT. OFFICERS WITH ANY SIGNIFICANT CHANGES TO THEIR RECORD (PROMOTION, SKILL BADGES, AWARDS AND DECORATIONS, DEPLOYMENT TIME, ETC) SHOULD STRONGLY CONSIDER TAKING A NEW OFFICIAL PHOTOGRAPH IN PREPARATION FOR THIS BOARD.

E. STANDARDIZED TESTS. APPLICANTS FOR GRADUATE EDUCATION PROGRAMS MUST SUBMIT A GRE, GMAT OR MILLER ANALOGIES TEST SCORE REGARDLESS OF UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS (NO MORE THAN FIVE YEARS OLD). THE GMAT IS REQUIRED BY SYRACUSE UNIVERSITY FOR THE COMPTROLLERSHIP PROGRAM. MINIMUM SCORES FOR BOARD CONSIDERATION IS 850 FOR GRE (TOTAL OF VERBAL AND QUANTITATIVE SCORES ONLY), 425 FOR GMAT, AND 42 FOR MILLER ANALOGIES. APPLICANTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CONTACTING ANY PROPOSED INSTITUTION TO DETERMINE SPECIFIC STANDARDIZED TEST REQUIREMENTS FOR THAT SCHOOL.

F. CONSULTANT'S ENDORSEMENT. APPLYING OFFICERS MUST SUBMIT A SIGNED ENDORSEMENT MEMORANDUM FROM THEIR CONSULTANT SUPPORTING THE OFFICER'S LTHET APPLICATION. THE FORMAT FOR THE CONSULTANT ENDORSEMENT IS LOCATED AT ENCLOSURE 2 OF THIS MESSAGE. CONSULTANTS MAY ADD TO THE CONTENT OF THEIR ENDORSEMENT AS THEY SEE FIT. THE LETTERHEAD AND OFFICE SYMBOL SHOULD BE THOSE OF THE CONSULTANT'S ORGANIZATION. IF AN OFFICER IS APPLYING FOR A PROGRAM THAT WOULD POTENTIALLY CHANGE THEIR AOC, THE POTENTIAL FUTURE CONSULTANT MUST INDICATE THEIR SUPPORT FOR THAT AOC CHANGE IN THE BOTTOM PORTION OF THE ENDORSEMENT. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE APPLYING OFFICER TO OBTAIN THE NECESSARY ENDORSEMENTS FROM THE APPROPRIATE CONSULTANTS.

G. ALL REQUIRED ACCEPTANCE LETTERS FROM THE DESIRED ACADEMIC INSTITUTION MUST BE PROVIDED TO THE LEADER DEVELOPMENT OFFICE NLT THAN 6 MONTHS PRIOR TO THE START DATE OF THE PROGRAM. NOTE: OFFICERS APPLYING FOR THE MASTERS OF SOCIAL WORK PROGRAM MUST APPLY FOR AND RECEIVE ADMISSION TO FAYETTEVILLE STATE UNIVERSITY. ADDITIONALLY, THE ACCEPTANCE LETTERS FROM FAYETTEVILLE STATE UNIVERSITY MUST BE PROVIDED AS PART OF THE ENTIRE LTHET BOARD APPLICATION. H. ORB/OMPF. ALL PERSONNEL MUST ENSURE THEIR OFFICER RECORD BRIEF (ORB) AND OFFICIAL MILITARY PERSONNEL FILE ARE CORRECT.

5. ELIGIBILITY TO APPLY.

A. GENERAL:

1. APPLICATIONS FROM OFFICERS WHO DO NOT MEET THE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA WILL BE RETURNED WITHOUT ACTION.

2. EACH PROGRAM MAY HAVE DISTINCT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS (RANK, PREVIOUS TRAINING PREREQUISITES, ETC). APPLYING OFFICERS SHOULD REVIEW THE SPECIFIC PROGRAM INFORMATION AT THE END OF THIS MESSAGE AND CONTACT THE RESPECTIVE CONSULTANT FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION.

B. CAPTAINS CAREER COURSE: MUST BE A GRADUATE OF A CAPTAINS CAREER COURSE PRIOR TO THE START OF TRAINING. OFFICERS WHO ARE SELECTED FOR THE CLINICAL LABORATORY OFFICER'S COURSE OR THE BLOOD BANK FELLOWSHIP ARE EXEMPT FROM THIS REQUIREMENT.

C. TIME IN SERVICE (TIS) REQUIREMENTS: NO LESS THAN 5 YEARS AND NO MORE THAN 13 YEARS AFCS (WAIVERABLE UP TO 17 YEARS) AT THE START OF CIVILIAN SCHOOLING OR LONG TERM TRAINING. COMMISSIONED OFFICERS REQUESTING TRAINING WITH INDUSTRY CANNOT HAVE LESS THAN 3 YEARS OR MORE THAN 19 YEARS AFCS PRIOR TO REQUESTING TRAINING IN TWI PROGRAMS. WARRANT OFFICERS MUST NOT EXCEED 24 YEARS OF AWOS AT THE TIME OF REQUESTING TRAINING, AND MUST HAVE ENOUGH SERVICE TIME AFTER COMPLETION OF THE TWI PROGRAM TO FULFILL THE INCURRED ADSO.

E. TIME ON STATION REQUIREMENTS:

1. CONUS: 2 YEARS TIME ON STATION (TOS) AT THE START DATE OF THE REQUESTED PROGRAM. TOS IS COMPUTED FROM THE MONTH OF ARRIVAL TO THE EXPECTED MONTH OF DEPARTURE. THIS IS NOT WAIVERABLE.

2. OCONUS: APPLICANTS MUST COMPLETE THEIR CURRENT TOUR TO INCLUDE ANY EXTENSION. OCONUS TOURS WILL NOT BE CURTAILED TO ALLOW PARTICIPATION IN LTHET. THIS IS NOT WAIVERABLE.

F. STANDARDIZED TESTS: REFER TO PARAGRAPH 3E OF THIS MESSAGE. IT IS IMPORTANT THAT OFFICERS PREPARE FOR AND SCHEDULE THEMSELVES TO TAKE ALL REQUIRED STANDARDIZED TESTS FOR THE LTHET APPLICATION, AS WELL AS ANY REQUIRED TESTS OF THE INSITUATION(S) TO WHICH THEY PLAN TO APPLY.

G. RANK: GENERALLY MUST BE A FIRST LIEUTENANT (PROMOTABLE), CAPTAIN OR

MAJOR. CERTAIN PROGRAMS MAY HAVE SPECIFIC RANK REQUIREMENTS BASED ON THE CONSULTANT'S GUIDANCE.

H. COMMUNICATION WITH HRC CAREER MANAGERS: APPLYING OFFICERS MUST DISCUSS THEIR LTHET APPLICATION AND INTENTIONS WITH THEIR HRC BRANCH CAREER MANAGER. I. OFFICERS WHO ARE NON-SELECT FOR PROMOTION. OFFICERS IN A NON-SELECT PROMOTION STATUS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO APPLY OR ATTEND TRAINING. OFFICERS WHO BECOME NON-SELECT FOR PROMOTION AWAITING A SELECTED TRAINING START DATE WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO START TRAINING. OFFICERS WHO BECOME NON-SELECT FOR PROMOTION WHILE IN TRAINING WILL BE REMOVED FROM THEIR TRAINING PROGRAM UNLESS APPROVAL TO COMPLETE TRAINING IS GRANTED BY THE MS CORPS CHIEF.

J. PREVIOUS LTHET PARTICIPANTS:

1. OFFICERS WHO HAVE PREVIOUSLY BEEN FULLY OR PARTIALLY FUNDED FOR LTHET ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR PROGRAMS AT THE SAME CIVILIAN EDUCATION LEVEL AS PREVIOUSLY TRAINED.

2. OFFICERS WHO ARE CURRENTLY COMPLETING AN ADSO FROM A PREVIOUS LTHET PROGRAM MUST HAVE COMPLETED THEIR ADSO BEFORE THEY CAN BEGIN ANOTHER LTHET PROGRAM. ADDITIONALLY, NO PERIOD OF AN ADSO CAN BE COMPLETED WHILE AN OFFICER IS IN A TRAINING PROGRAM.

K. NUMBER OF PROGRAMS: OFFICERS MAY APPLY FOR NO MORE THAN TWO (2) PROGRAMS.

L. ATTENDING COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES: APPLYING OFFICERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CONTACTING EACH POTENTIAL SCHOOL/INSTITUTION TO WHICH THEY WILL APPLY FOR THE PURPOSE OF COMPLETING THEIR SEPARATE ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS. THE INSTITUTION MUST BE REGIONALLY OR NATIONALLY ACCREDITED, AND MEET TUITION GUIDELINES (NORMALLY NOT EXCEEDING \$15,000/YEAR). APPLICANTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO APPLY AT PUBLIC UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES TO WHICH THEY WOULD QUALIFY FOR IN-STATE TUITION.

OFFICERS APPLYING TO PRIVATE SCHOOLS OR SCHOOLS THAT REQUIRE IN EXCESS OF \$15,000 PER YEAR FOR TUITION MUST REQUEST AN EXCEPTION TO POLICY THROUGH THE CHIEF, AMEDD LEADER DEVELOPMENT (HRC) AND STATE A CLEAR JUSTIFICATION FOR THEIR REQUEST. IT IS KNOWN THAT SYRACUSE UNIVERSITY (DEFENSE COMPTROLLERSHIP MASTERS DEGREE PROGRAM), THE HARVARD KENNEDY SCHOOL OF GOVERNMENT AND GEORGE WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY (MPA IN LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS), AND THE UNIVERSITY OF PITTSBURGH (MASTERS DEGREE PROGRAM IN HEALTH INFORMATION MANAGEMENT) REQUIRE IN EXCESS OF \$15,000 PER YEAR IN TUITION COSTS. OFFICERS APPLYING FOR THESE PROGRAMS ARE NOT REQUIRED TO REQUEST AN EXCEPTION TO POLICY FOR ANNUAL TUITION COSTS.
