

## Information Paper

### Subject: Industrial Base Maintenance Contract

1. **Purpose:** To provide information on the Industrial Base Maintenance Contract for military unique auto injectors.

### 2. Facts:

A. The IBMC covers the following military unique items:

- (1) Mark I Kits, NSN 6505-01-174-9919
- (2) Diazepam Auto injector (CANA), NSN 6505-01-274-0951
- (3) Atropine Auto injector, NSN 6505-00-926-9083
- (4) Pralidoxime Chloride Auto injector, NSN 6505-01-125-3248
- (5) Morphine Auto injector, NSN 6505-01-302-5530
- (6) Antidote Nerve Agent Auto injector (ATNAA), NSN 6505-01-362-7427

B. Contract provides for:

- (1) Base Maintenance/Service. Provides labor, services and incremental production as directed by the Government.
- (2) Logistics Maintenance. Provides for the segregation of goods, disassembly into components, shelf life extension program, and storage.
- (3) Deployable Force Package (DFP) Program. Provides storage, assembly, and shipment of assets in support of Individual Service Member (ISM) initial issue requirements.
- (4) Base Maintenance/Material. Provides auto injectors listed above using refurbished and/or new components.
- (5) Mobilization Surge Option. Provide materiel in the event of a mobilization surge contingency or other Government requirement. Stockpile of raw components are maintained to expedite production of assets.
- (6) Program Management under Readiness Enhancement Program (REP). Trained workforce is maintained in case 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> shifts are required to be added to support the readiness requirements.

C. Contract is awarded and managed by the Defense Supply Center Philadelphia (DSCP). Generally, contract is for a three-year period (base year with 2 option years).
