

FORCE SUSTAINMENT DIRECTORATE

Force Sustainment Directorate (FSD) provides medical materiel support to all Army components (Active, Reserve, and National Guard) to optimize the medical materiel readiness of tactical Army organizations. In other words, FSD is where the "medical materiel meets the customer." FSD is USAMMA's central business unit with four distinct units:

- ◆ Acquisition Data Synchronization Division
- ◆ Production and Assembly Management Division
- ◆ Materiel Fielding Division

FSD is The Surgeon General's and the AMEDD's lead to execute four major Army medical logistics programs:

- ◆ TO&E Medical Materiel Modernization Program (MDEP FL8D)
- ◆ Medical Equipment Reset Program
- ◆ Medical Left Behind Equipment (LBE) Program
- ◆ Medical Equipment Responsible Retrograde (R2)

USAMMA'S FORCE SUSTAINMENT DIRECTORATE

ACQUISITION DATA SYNCHRONIZATION DIVISION (ADSD)

- ◆ Manage medical National Stock Numbers (NSN) from creation through life cycle as Tri-Service executive agent
- ◆ Secondary Inventory Control Activity (SICA), responsible for Army medical enterprise data management
- ◆ Finalize and manage the approved Bill of Materiel (BOM 4) in TEWLS
- ◆ Manage Medical NSN Material Master Data in the TEWLS enterprise data base
- ◆ Create Unit Assemblages (UA) Reports and execute BOM comparisons
- ◆ Manage medical portion of Supply Bulletin (SB) 700-20
- ◆ Produce automated Supply Catalogs in LIW for medical sets



PRODUCTION / ASSEMBLY MANAGEMENT DIVISION (P/AMD)

- ◆ Procures medical materiel, builds medical sets, kits, and assemblages
- ◆ Manages depot and contracted assembly operations
- ◆ Army's excess medical materiel manager
- ◆ Manage tailored Unit Assemblages (UAs) and Bill of Materiel (BOM)
- ◆ Disassemble previously fielded medical materiel and equipment

MATERIEL FIELDING DIVISION (MFD)

- ◆ Conduct world-wide medical and non-medical materiel release fielding and transfer
- ◆ Support multiple Army Force Generation (ARFORGEN) tenets — primarily Army Reset, LBE and R2 programs
- ◆ Manage and document all materiel and equipment fielded to the force ensuring proper accountability
- ◆ Lateral transfers fielded assets via PBUSE to PBUSE transaction with gaining unit
- ◆ Provide disposition instructions for displaced materiel and equipment
- ◆ Provide personnel to staff USAMMA's Medical Logistics Support Team (MLST), to support world-wide contingency operations

OTHER FSD RESPONSIBILITIES:

- ◆ Manage USAMMA's forward presence through liaisons embedded at the respective Army Field Support Brigades (AFSB) at Forts Bragg, Campbell, Carson, Hood, Lewis, and Army Sustainment Command, Rock Island
- ◆ Manage non-medical Associated Support Items of Equipment (ASIOE) such as power generation/distribution equipment, shelters, and material handling equipment
- ◆ Deployable Medical Systems (DEPMEDS) Sustainment Education
- ◆ Manage Loan and Lease Agreements for the Agency
