CPT Ivette Daley hails from Canovanas, Puerto Rico. She enlisted in the United States Army in 2003 as a Veterinary Food Inspector (68R). CPT Daley attended Basic Training at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri and Advanced Individual Training (AIT) at Joint Base San Antonio, Texas. CPT Daley was selected for the Green to Gold Active Duty Option Program in 2009. In 2011, she graduated from Wayland Baptist University with a Bachelors of Applied Science in Food Science and Nutrition Studies; and commissioned into the Medical Service Corps in 2011 at the University of Texas Antonio as a distinguished military graduate.

In 2011, CPT Daley attended the Army Medical Department (AMEDD) Basic Officer Course (BOLC) at Joint Base San Antonio, TX. Her first assignment following BOLC was the 602nd Area Support Medical Company (ASMC), 261st Multi-functional Medical Battalion (MMB), 44th Medical Brigade (MED BDE) located at Fort Bragg, NC. While assigned to the 602nd ASMC, she served as the Treatment Platoon Leader. During her time at the 44th MED BDE, she served as the Headquarters and Headquarters Company (HHC), 44th MED BDE, Executive Officer as well as the Chief of Logistic Plans. Following this assignment CPT Daley attended the Medical Logistics Course at Joint Base San Antonio, TX. In 2015, after her attendance to the Medical Logistics Officer Course, she was assigned to the 2nd Infantry brigade combat team (IBCT) at Fort Stewart, GA as the Brigade Medical Operations Officer. She remained in 2IBCT and in 2016 took command of the HHC, 703rd Brigade Support Battalion (BSB). In 2017, after CPT Daley finished command, she attended the AMEDD Captain's Career Course (CCC). After CCC, CPT Daley was assigned to the 5-306th BSB, 188th Infantry Brigade (INF BDE), Fort Stewart, GA as the Support Operations (SPO) Medical Logistics Officer Observer, Coach, Trainer (OC/T). In 2018, CPT Daley was selected to become the 188th INF BDE Brigade Medical Officer OC/T.

CPT Daley's military education includes Primary Leadership Development Course, Military Food Safety and Security Course, Combatives Level 1-2, AMEDD BOLC, Unit Movement Officer Course, SHARP Course, Medical Logistics' Officer Course, SPO Course Phase 1, Company Commander and First Sergeant Course, AMEDD CCC, and Observer, Coach Trainer Course.

CPT Daley's awards and decorations include the Meritorious Service Medal, Army Commendation Medal (fourth oak leaf cluster), the Army Achievement Medal (fifth oak leaf cluster), the Good Conduct Medal (2nd award), National Defense Service Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, Non-Commissioned Officer Professional Development Ribbon, and the Army Service Ribbon.
